



Dual Eligible Enrollment by Medicare Program and State

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About This Work

These data tables provide state-by-state counts of dual Medicare-Medicaid eligible individuals enrolled in different aspects of the Medicare program, including Traditional Medicare and Medicare Advantage, as well as specific plan types such as Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans and Medicare-Medicaid Plans.

Data Source and Notes

ATI Advisory analyzed the December 2023 Medicare Master Beneficiary Summary File to calculate total beneficiary counts by Medicare program (FFS, MA) and dual eligibility. ATI merged MBSF data with the 2023Q2 Plan Benefit Package data to identify D-SNP and MMP enrollment. Any cells with less than 11 beneficiaries were suppressed and not included in the final report.

MA enrollments are limited to Medicare beneficiaries residing in MA plan's service area only. Dual eligible beneficiaries in Puerto Rico are not included in the analysis.



Full Benefit Dual Eligible Individuals

Medicare beneficiaries who are also entitled to full Medicaid benefits. This analysis defines "Full Benefit Dual Eligible" individuals as Medicare beneficiaries with full Medicaid coverage as of December 2023.

- **D-SNP**: Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan
- **FFS**: Fee-for-Service, also known as Traditional Medicare

- **MMP**: Medicare-Medicaid Plan
- **Non-SNP MA**: All types of Medicare Advantage plans that are not Special Needs Plans
- **PACE**: Program of All-inclusive Care for the Elderly



Partial Benefit Dual Eligible Individuals

Medicare beneficiaries who receive financial assistance for certain Medicare costs from their state Medicaid program, but do not qualify for full Medicaid benefits such as long-term services or supports. This analysis defines "Partial Benefit Dual Eligible" individuals as Medicare beneficiaries who had partial Medicaid coverage as of December 2023.
