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HOW DID D-SNP INTEGRATION CHANGE BY COUNTY IN 2024?

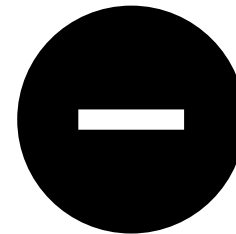
State models integrating Medicare and Medicaid through D-SNPs continue to evolve.

The ATI team has county-level insights into the availability and market conditions for these plans, ranging from Medicare-Medicaid Plans to D-SNPs that are Fully Integrated (FIDE), Highly Integrated (HIDE), or Coordination Only (CO).



→ **42 counties have a more integrated plan type in 2024, compared to 2023.**

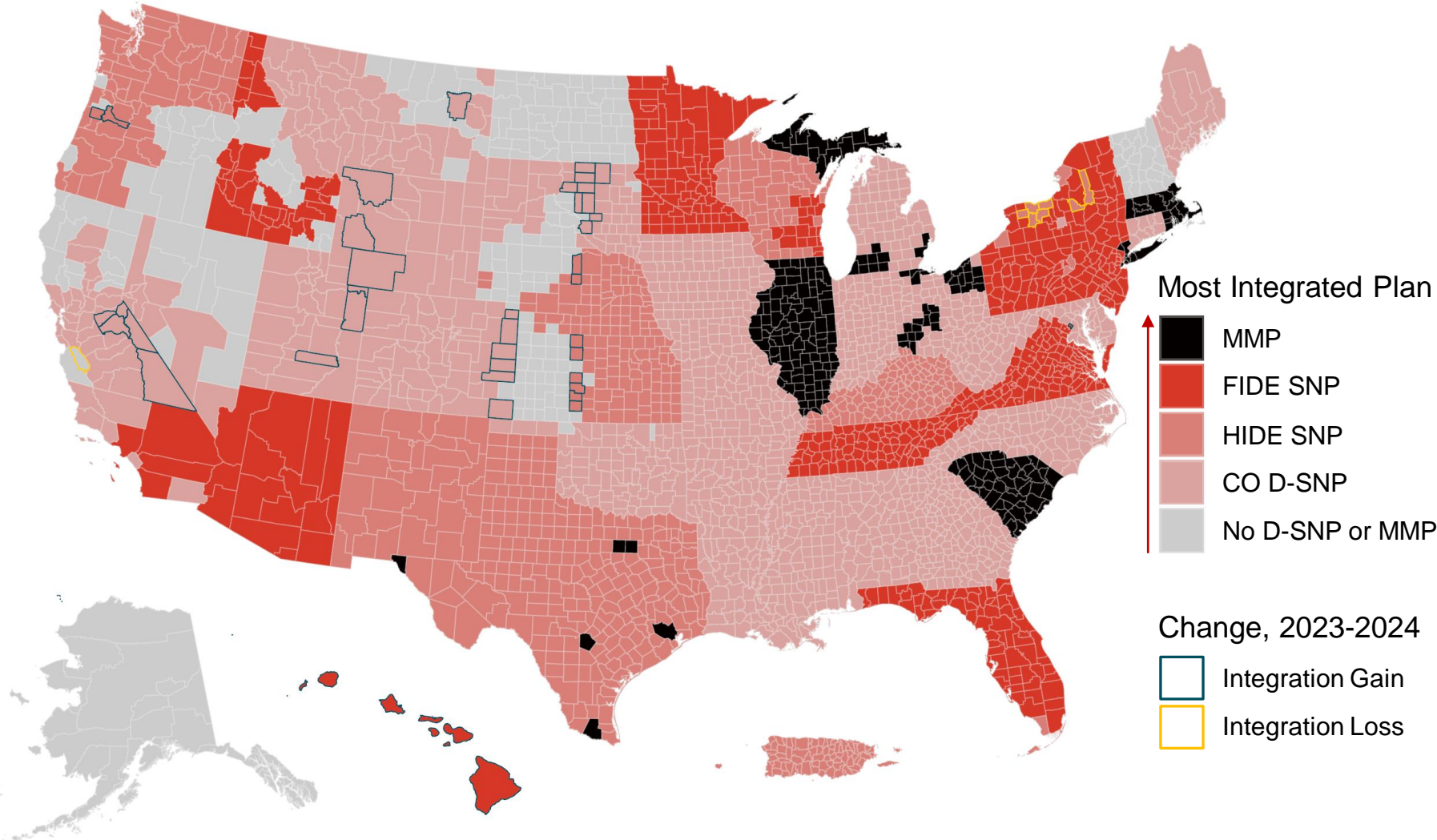
- CO D-SNP to HIDE SNP in certain Oregon and Nebraska counties
- HIDE SNP to FIDE SNP in Hawaii and DC
- No D-SNP to CO D-SNP in certain California, Colorado, Montana, South Dakota, Utah, and Wyoming counties
- No D-SNP to HIDE SNP in certain Kansas counties



→ **8 counties have a less integrated plan type in 2024, compared to 2023.**

- CO D-SNP to No D-SNP in one California county
- FIDE SNP to HIDE SNP in certain New York counties

MOST INTEGRATED PLAN BY COUNTY IN 2024 WITH CHANGE IN MOST INTEGRATED PLAN FROM 2023



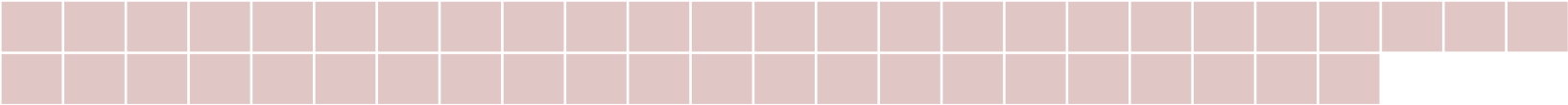

→ Number of states and territories that have **FIDE SNPs**

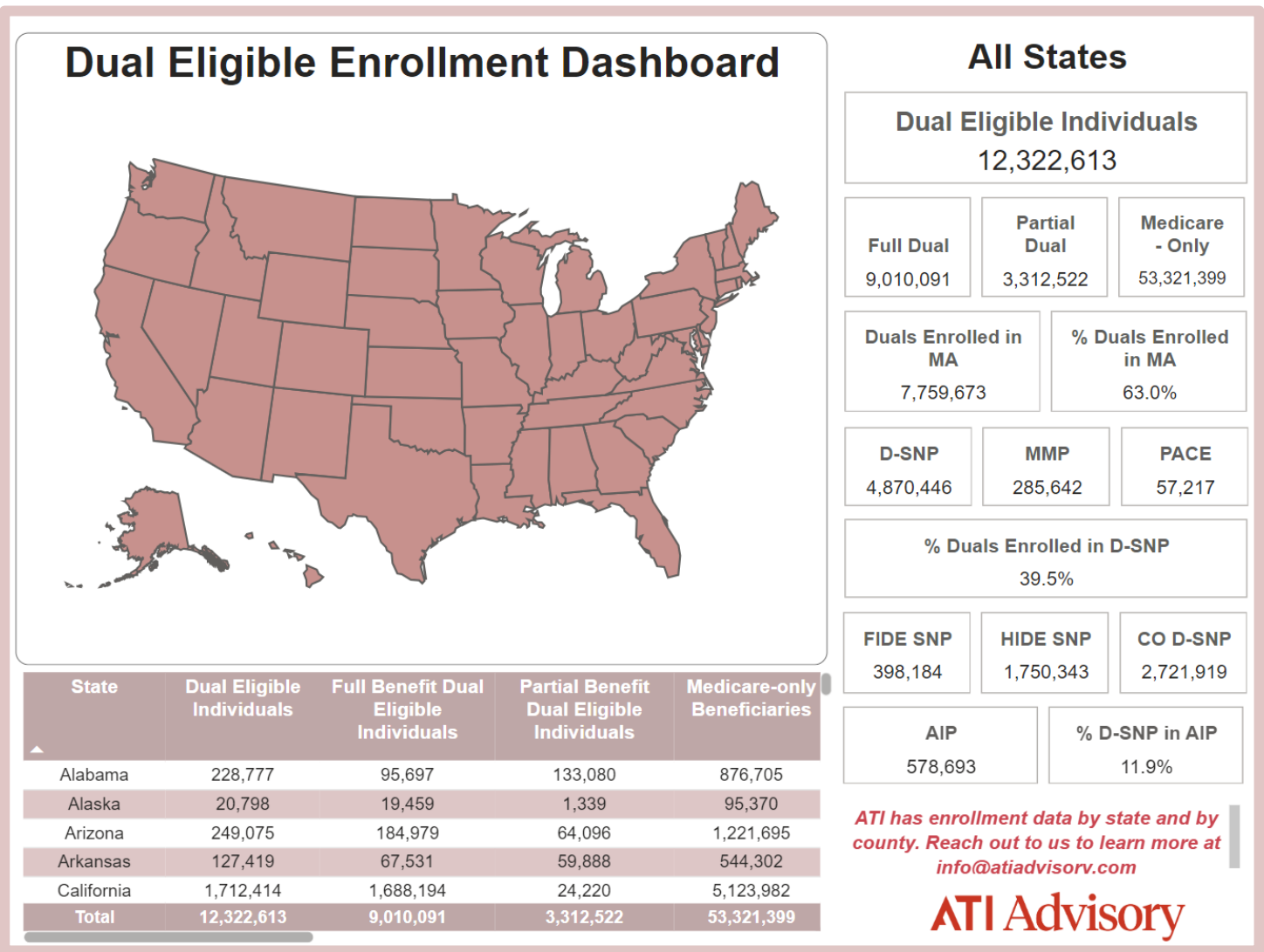


→ Number of states and territories that have plans that **leverage exclusively aligned enrollment** and are considered an AIP



FIDE SNP: Fully-Integrated D-SNP; D-SNP legal entity also has Medicaid financial and clinical risk for LTSS and BH in the state
EAE: Exclusively aligned enrollment - D-SNPs that only enroll individuals for whom they also have Medicaid financial and clinical risk (e.g., via a companion Medicaid MCO contract)
AIP: Applicable integrated plan, a D-SNP with exclusively aligned enrollment and subject to enhanced integration requirements

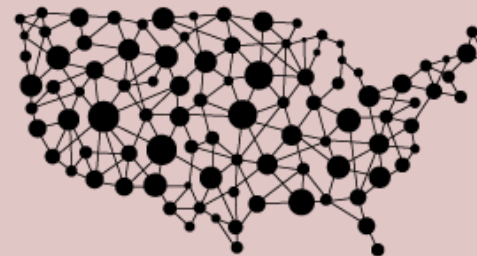


What you can learn from this dashboard:
